#### **Requirements for Exchange Students**

#### GPA

Language Proficiency

GPA of 2.5 or higher is preferred on a 4.0 scale

\*Other requirements except below are as per the agreement.

Japanese Course

· Required to have studied the Japanese language for 150 hours or more

• To be able to read and write Hiragana and Katakana

English Course

• To have the English language proficiency equivalent to TOEFL iBT score of 62 or IELTS score of 5.0 for students from non-English-speaking countries and regions

#### Visa

KUFS will do proxy application for a Certificate of Eligibility (COE). Once a COE is issued, KUFS will send PDF files (COE and acceptance letter) to partner universities by email. Students should obtain a Student Visa at the nearest Japanese Embassy or Consulate upon receipt of the PDF files from KUFS.

#### National Health Insurance

All international students residing in Japan for over 3 months are required to enroll in the Japanese Health Insurance.

Those students holding a Student Visa are required to pay approx. 18,000 yen per year.

#### Accommodation

#### Accommodation Arrangement by KUFS

KUFS will arrange accommodations only for those who have submitted a request on the online application system. All rooms arranged by KUFS are furnished single rooms. A rent must be paid by Flywire per semester (min. 378,000 yen~ max. 450,000 yen). The first rent payment (for the 1st semester) is due before coming to Japan, and the second rent payment (for the 2nd semester) is due before the second semester begins. The details will be informed from Housing Support after completing the application procedures.

#### Cost of Living

All international students are recommended to have approx. 900,000 yen available per semester and 1,800,000 yen per year to cover their rent, meals, learning materials, and any other personal costs. \*may vary depending on personal lifestyle
