This course provides students who already have an extensive vocabulary and knowledge of grammatical structures with a more in-depth study of the language with attention to verb conjugation, noun forms and syntactic structure of modern Hebrew.

Students will work on understanding and producing extensive text in modern Hebrew through exposure to literature, poetry, music, movies and everyday conversations.

All four skills are emphasized throughout the course - comprehension, reading, speaking and writing - using a wide selection and range of vocabulary and language structure.

Oral Communication - be able to express ideas and opinions clearly and fluently using a precise and varied vocabulary

Reading Comprehension - understand various Hebrew text

Written Expression - write coherently in consideration of both form and content
