- Paid research assistant positions with field experts

**CURL Fellowships:** \$1,500 fellowships are awarded each year to support students’ independent research projects under the mentorship of a CURL faculty associate.

**CURL Travel Bursaries:** \$500 bursaries are awarded each year to enable students to travel to conferences, workshops and other events that foster research and career development.

**CURL Conferences:** Two opportunities to showcase your discoveries: The Fall Exhibition and Spring Conference offer on-campus opportunities for students to present their research in multiple formats.

Both Jiazheng and Dr. Entezarkheir recognize the value of research for successful graduate school applications. For students who eventually want to apply to graduate school, Dr. Entezarkheir explains, “When the selection committee sees a student is already familiar with how to generate tangible research, that is definitely a bonus.”

On the other side of the application table, Jiazheng shares, “CURL is exceptional at the undergraduate level, and it will be great for my applications to universities across Canada. More than that, once I begin graduate school, I’ll already be ahead of many of my classmates who have not experienced this type of intensive growth experience.”
