

The Scotiabank Scholars program is a unique two-year curriculum, designed by Huron University in collaboration with TVDSB, for high school students. Together, Huron and Scotiabank aim to break down barriers for accessing postsecondary education by helping Scotiabank Scholars navigate university opportunities and application processes.

Participating students will engage in topics including skill development, career exploration, wellness, and university preparation to set students up for success to pursue their passions at any university. With sessions held on-campus at Huron, students will gain early exposure to learning within a postsecondary environment, with all costs proudly covered by Scotiabank and Huron. Participating Scotiabank Scholars may be eligible to apply for a full scholarship opportunity to attend Huron University.
