Course Description:

This is a third-level course that builds upon language competence and skills developed previously in modern standard Chinese (Mandarin). Students will learn more complex grammatical structures and gain a larger vocabulary (approximately 1600 characters). The focus of this course will be on listening and speaking skills. Special emphasis will be given to advanced conversation and translation techniques.

Learning Outcomes:

Recognize 1600 basic characters.
Apply essential grammatical patterns and expressions in writing and speaking.
Improve communication skills and feel confident to conduct dialogue in various contexts in modern standard Chinese.
Develop translation skills.
Plan, organize and produce a short script in a small group.
