<b>How to apply Step 1</b>	Applications are due the first week of December. You need to submit: an application form, two reference letters, a 250 word statement about why you are a good candidate for the exchange program, a resume, and the \$25 application fee.
<b>How to apply Step 2</b>	If Huron accepts you as an exchange participant, we will nominate you to the partner university. You will then be asked to fill out their application form. Fall Term Application Deadline: August 3 <sup>rd</sup> Spring Term Application Deadline: January 27 <sup>th</sup>
<b>Course Information</b>	Exchange students must have their course section pre-approved by Huron. <b>Accommodation</b>	Department of International Cooperation and Exchange will help allocate students in the dorms of Building 17 or Conference Center inside the campus.
<b>Visa needed?</b>	Visa Application JW202 Form will be mailed to Huron three weeks after the application is received. <b>Health Insurance</b>	Students must acquire Chinese Comprehensive Hospitalization Insurance, which is \$60 CAD for one semester, as well as have a psychical check-up in Beijing International Travel Health Center.
