Semester Dates	Fall Term: September 21 st – January 28 th Spring Term: April 7 th – August 5 th
How to apply Step 1	Applications are due the first week of December. You need to submit: an application form, two reference letters, a 250 word statement about why you are a good candidate for the exchange program, a resume, and the \$25 application fee.
How to apply Step 2	If Huron accepts you as an exchange participant, we will nominate you to the partner university. You will then be asked to fill out their application form. Course Information	Exchange students must have their course section pre-approved by Huron. Browse the course information and the contact your department chair. For more info click here
Accommodation	The university guarantees accommodation to incoming exchange students accommodation will be in the form of a homestay.
Visa needed?	All the students accepted in program must apply for student visas in Canada one month before arrival.
Health Insurance	Mandatory for all international students. The minimum coverage of your own insurance from Canada should be at least \$60,000 CAD.
Costs	Tuition is paid to Huron. You are responsible for living and travel expenses. Other Costs: Transport, excursions
