How to apply Step 1	Applications are due the first week of December. You need to submit: an
	application form, two reference letters, a 500 word statement about why you are a good candidate for the exchange program, a resume, and the \$25 application fee.
How to apply Step 2	If Huron accepts you as an exchange participant, we will nominate you to the partner university. You will then be asked to fill out their application form. Accommodation	The university provides accommodation in the form of a single dormitory room or apartment for approximately \$250 CAD per month. See: http://www.kufs.ac.jp/en/partner/fees.html
Visa needed?	Apply for a "College Student Visa" at a Japanese Embassy / Consulate in Canada before entrance.
Health Insurance	Mandatory for all international students. Students must purchase Japan's National Health Insurance (~\$220 CDN) which covers 70% of medical costs, with the remaining 30% being covered by the student. The minimum coverage of your own insurance from Canada should be at least \$60,000 CAD. <b>See:</b> <u>http://www.kufs.ac.jp/en/partner/health_insurance.html</u>
