

Please note the following:

- Incoming exchange students can come to Huron for Fall term (September to December), Winter term (January to April), or the full academic year (September to April).
- At Huron, a full course load for the academic year (September to April) is 5.0 courses.
- Students can explore course offerings (including subject name, course number, class number, etc) here (be sure to narrow your search by "Campus- Huron"):

- Once students have their Student ID and password, they can create a draft schedule here:

- Courses that end in "A" or "F" are offered Fall term (September to December) and are each worth 0.5 credits; courses that end in "B" or "G" are offered Winter term (January to April) and are each worth 0.5 credits; courses that end in "E" or have no suffix run from September to April and are each worth 1.0 credits.
- Courses offered at Huron have section numbers that begin with "55" such as "550", "551", "552". Section numbers that begin with "00", "53", or "57" are not offered at Huron.
- Incoming exchange students must take all of their exchange courses at Huron (they cannot take any courses at Western).
- Students cannot enrol in a course if it is listed as "Full".
- Once students are enrolled in courses, they are encouraged to share their final timetable with their home institution.
- Upon completion of exchange courses, students can request an official transcript through their Student Centre.
