

THE HURON – UWC GLOBAL LEADER WITH HEART AWARD

The Huron – UWC Global Leader with Heart Award will cover full tuition, books, ancillary fees, and accommodation support for four years for one eligible student each year from any UWC school worldwide

Deadline to Apply: November 1, 2022

Student Eligibility Criteria

- Must be an international student who will be studying in Canada on a Study Permit.
- Must be entering Huron from a UWC school and applying for your first undergraduate degree.
- Must meet Huron's admission and English language proficiency requirements
- Must be currently enrolled at a UWC School on a full scholarship, demonstrating a level of financial need that would otherwise prevent the student from pursuing a Huron education

Huron's emphasis on developing **Leaders with Heart** means that we care about the heart as much as the mind. We attract students who are drawn to service and determined to use their academic and career success to positively impact global society and take on the world's toughest challenges. Therefore, these scholarships are quite holistic in nature and look far beyond grades alone: it is assessed on a combination of three main components in the application process:

Academics: A minimum predicted score of 35 IBDP points or higher (including bonus points for EE & TOK).

Extracurricular: In the application, students can describe between 1 to 5 of their most notable extra-curricular, leadership or community service achievements from the past four years. These can be achievements within the school or even those in their wider local or global community outside of school. They will also be required to submit a Statement of Purpose, with questions to respond to.

School Nomination: A school counsellor will also be required to complete a Letter of Recommendation (LOR) to formally nominate the student for this scholarship and give the Scholarship Committee a greater insight into the kind of student and leader the applicant is.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS APPLYING TO THE HURON – UWC GLOBAL LEADER WITH HEART AWARD

Step 1: The student must submit their application to a Huron program. UWC Students can apply directly to Huron using our direct application by [clicking here](#). Scholarship students can use the code **1863** to waive the application fee.

Step 2: The student will be able to access the UWC scholarship form in the scholarship section of their Huron Application Portal. The student must submit all required components of the scholarship application and upload the signed, Early Decision Agreement Form before November 1, 2022.

Step 3: During the application process, the student will be able to submit the email address of the counsellor who is nominating them for the scholarship. The counsellor will receive an email from Huron with instructions to submit their nomination and letter of recommendation (LOR). This must be received by Huron before November 1, 2022.

Step 4: Short-listed applicants will be invited to take part in a video interview

Step 5: The recipient of the Huron – UWC Global Leader with Heart Award will be notified by December 15, 2022.

Go to the Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC) website at ouac.on.ca. Huron is listed under Western University. Only apply to a program once. Huron OUAC codes are: EHD = Management and Organizational Studies programs; EHO = Social Science programs; EHA = Arts programs.

Is Huron the only university you're applying to in Ontario? You may be eligible to apply using Huron's **Internal Application**. Do not use this application if you have already applied using the OUAC website.

INTERNATIONAL ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

\$4,000 TO \$60,000 (\$1,000 - \$15,000 per year renewable over 4 years)

All international students applying to Huron are automatically assessed for this scholarship, based on their academic results. No supplemental application is required.

Eligibility: Recipients will have an admission average of 85% or higher (as calculated by Huron). The amount you are eligible for is determined by your application round:

THE INTERNATIONAL PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

50% OF TUITION Up to 10 available, renewable for up to four years.

Huron's most prestigious international student award. This merit-based scholarship is open to applicants with an admission average of 90% or higher (as calculated by Huron) who demonstrate an exceptional record of extra curricular and community involvement and a passion to positively contribute to global society.

HOW TO APPLY:

- STEP 1**  Submit your application to a Huron program
- STEP 2**  Complete the International Presidential Scholarship Application Form before February 1, 2023
- STEP 3**  Have your counselor send Huron the School Nomination Form and Recommendation Letter before February 1, 2023
- STEP 4**  Take part in a video interview by the Scholarship Committee (short-listed candidates only)
- STEP 5**  Recipients of the International Presidential Scholarship will be notified in March 2023

FINANCIAL AID

5% - 50% OF TUITION, renewable for up to four years

This needs-based application is open to admitted international students who can demonstrate significant financial needs. Financial Aid may be awarded in various amounts, depending on an assessment of your overall application.

Deadline: February 1, 2023

HOW TO APPLY:

- STEP 1**  Submit your application to a Huron program.
- STEP 2**  Submit the Huron International Financial Aid Form (HIFAF), and required financial documents before February 1, 2023.
- STEP 3**  Notification of financial aid will be sent out in March 2023.

International students can work off-campus up to 20 hours per week during the school year and full-time hours in the summer. There is no fixed limit of hours for part-time work on campus too!


