FLAG POLICY

Approved by the Principal, November 2012

The Principal of Huron holds responsibility for the Huron University College flag.

The Huron flag displays the arms of Huron University College: shield, crown, crossed swords and beaver and are adapted from the arms of the Bishop of Huron to strict heraldic conventions, and have been approved and registered by the Canadian Heraldic Authority.

The Huron flag shall only be raised on Huron property and may be made available for display at official Huron events. The decision to lower the flag to half-staff shall be made the Principal.

The Huron flag is not to be sold or otherwise traded and shall be displayed in a manner that is keeping with flag etiquette. For reference please see:
