

Quick Reference: MOS – What Courses Should I Take in First Year

All Huron students take a general first year. If you would like to study MOS (Management and Organizational Studies), below are the courses you need for each of the primary MOS streams. Students must successfully complete at least 5.0 first year credits before they will be considered for their chosen MOS module. Students require an average of at least 70% on their last 5.0 courses to be admitted into a MOS Specialization for their second year. An average of at least 73% is required for a MOS Honors Specialization module. For additional information, visit the Western Academic Calendar website.

- 1.0: designated essay courses numbered 1000-1999
- 0.5: elective number 1000-1999

- 1.0: designated essay courses numbered 1000-1999
- 0.5: elective number 1000-1999

- 1.0 from: *CGS 1023F/G, *Philosophy 1230A/B, *Philosophy 1250F/G, *Philosophy 1370A/B, *Political Science 1020E, Sociology 1020, Sociology 1021E
- 1.0: designated essay courses numbered 1000-1999
